Overview

Hands-on UCM training for typical software development environments. For UCM users, this one-day course is the recommended follow-on to the *ClearCase Fundamentals* course.

Sites integrating UCM and ClearQuest should take the one-day *UCM/ClearQuest Integration Fundamentals* course. Sites adopting ClearCase only should take the one-day *ClearCase Intermediate* course. Power users should refer to the *Curriculum Overview* for other courses in the ClearCase, UCM, and UCM/ClearQuest Integration tracks.

ClearCase Fundamentals course or equivalent ClearCase experience.

Objectives

At the end of this course, students will understand UCM concepts and their role in configuration management. They will be able to use ClearCase and UCM tools and procedures in their work environment.
